How to create your bookmark:

- ❖ *On the front of the bookmark:*
 - ✓ Title: Write the title of the book in the designated area.
 - ✓ Author: Write the author's name in the designated area.
 - ✓ Characters: List the names of the main characters in the story in the designated area.
 - ✓ Main Story Problem: Record what the main problem of the story is, how the problem began and who is involved in the problem. (in the designated area).
- ❖ *On the back of the bookmark:*
 - ✓ Events: List the important events in the story (in the designated area).
 - ✓ Resolution: Describe how the problem was resolved and who was involved in the resolution.(in the designated area).
 - ✓ Rate the book: Tell your opinion of the book in the designated area. List specific details describing why you liked or disliked the book.
 - ✓ Decorate: When you are finished filling in the information cut out the bookmark template and fold it in half to create your bookmark. You may also want to neatly add pictures and color your bookmark to make it creative and colorful!
