

Team 7-2 Expectations and Policies

All of the teachers on Team 7-2 will implement these policies and expectations dealing with behavior, rewards, homework, late work, and classroom procedures.

Student Expectations: All students are responsible to follow the rules set forth by the Forest Hills School District noted in your student handbook.

- Respect others, yourself, classroom and school property.
- Take responsibility for your work, your actions, and your choices.
- Be on time, have all necessary materials and be ready to learn.
- Follow directions and make good use of class time.

Following expectations will be rewarded by:

- Verbal Praise
- Positive contact with parents
- Team SOAR awards given twice a quarter to individual students
- Popcorn with the Principal and other incentives offered

If your choices and actions do not reflect the expectations, the consequences are:

- Warnings
- Calls home/emails
- Conferences- Team Court
- Team Detention
- Administrative Referral

Grading Scale: The grading scale will follow that of the district.

93-100% A 85-92% B 76-84% C 70-75% D Below 70% F

Late and Absent Work: In all four of the core classes students will be able to turn in any late work ONE day after the assigned date with a reduction in points. No late work will be accepted after the one day grace period. Students who are absent have 2 days for every class day missed.

**Team 72 reserves the right to place students who have 4 or more missing assignments in core classes in the weekly Homework Academy which is conducted during advisory. The Homework Academy's purpose is to encourage checking progress book, and encourage students to complete their missing work.

Block Schedule: Team 7.2 will be in a block schedule format two days of the week. This will occur on Wednesdays and Thursdays. On these days students will only see two core teachers for 90 min each and have

a SOAR time built in for 40 min of intervention, enrichment, literacy etc. This allows us as a team to do some projects and hands on activities with our classes along with doing cross curricular things as a team. We will go over what this looks like at Open House so you have a clearer picture.

Participation Points: Each core teacher will give ten points per week for participation, for coming to class on time, being prepared, being on task during an activity, participating in class activities/discussions, not borrowing supplies from a teacher that they are supposed to have etc. These scores will appear in progress book.
